All children deserve safe and loving homes.

Did you know that 1 in 3 youth in foster care are LGBTQ?
Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and questioning
(LGBTQ) youth are over-represented in foster care
nationwide. They are more likely to experience
discrimination, abuse, neglect and harm.

Without safe foster home placements, LGBTQ youth are at high risk for homelessness and sexual exploitation.
